

SNOWFLAKE ACADEMY QUILT SHOW

To display a quilt in the annual Snowflake Academy Quilt Show, please fill out the application and return by **July 15, 2016**, to the Snowflake/Taylor library. We need the applications by this date to organize the event. If you are still working on a quilt, just remember that it must be brought to the Snowflake Academy building (downstairs, north side) on **Monday, July 18 between 10 am and 12 noon**. (We need a few days to arrange and hang the quilts up for display)

The show will be July 22 and 23, 2016 during the Pioneer Days celebration.

1. Please fill out an application for each quilt (required so that we can fill out a display card for each quilt). Limit is two or three quilts per person.
2. We want quilts that have not been displayed in this particular quilt show before (important).
3. Bring your quilts in a bag that has your name written by a marker in large letters.
4. **All those who enter a quilt need to work at the show** an hour or two on either day to help us control traffic and protect the quilts. Please indicate on the application the day and hours you can help. We will give you your assignment when you bring your quilt to the Academy.
5. If you have a quilt you would like to sell, there is a separate application to fill out for the sale quilt. Remember that you legally should not sell a quilt designed by someone else without permission from that person. The Academy will sell it on consignment and keep 25% of your sale price. The Academy board is not responsible for its sale other than to collect the money.
6. If you know someone who would like to display a quilt, please take an application for her/him.
7. Ribbons for Best of Show, First, Second, and Third will be awarded by judges.
8. **Please pick up your quilt no earlier than between 4:30 and 5 p.m. Saturday, July 23 or ask someone to do so. If you do not pick up your quilt it will be left in the building over the weekend**, then taken to the Library where it will be available for pickup on Tuesday, July 26, between 10:30-11:30 a.m.

All proceeds go to the Academy building. Board members receive no stipends and often use their own money to accomplish our various projects. We appreciate your willingness and desire to help the Snowflake Academy Foundation restore and renovate the old academy building so that it can be a public library and house special collections in this area. Any donation you wish to make will be greatly appreciated!
